

# ENGLISH

Students will engage with simple informative texts, identifying the differences between informative and narrative texts. Students will read, view and comprehend informative texts. They will create short written texts using words and images.

# MATHEMATICS

Students will sort, describe and name familiar two-dimensional shapes. They will make connections between number names, numerals and quantities up to 10. Students will count to and from 20 and order small collections.

### SCIENCE

Students will represent, share and reflect on observations about the needs of living things and how an environment can affect them. Students will ask and respond to science questions.
