OTHER LEARNING AREAS

Visual Art- This term students will explore how found objects can communicate meaning in three-dimensional artworks.

The Arts- (Miss Jess McDonald) This term students will compose a short accompaniment to go with a celebration song. In Drama students will create a drama based on a place special to them, shown through day and night to compare.

Digital Technologies- (Ms Nat Rayner) This term students will explore and manipulate different types of data and transform data into information. They will create a Microsoft Excel Spreadsheet that presents data as meaningful information to address a school or community issue.

HPE (Miss Aggie Dalton) This term in Physical Education students will create an athletic-themed sequence using fundamental movement skills and elements of movement. They will perform running, jumping and throwing sequences in authentic situations. This term in health they will use decision-making skills to select and demonstrate strategies that help them stay healthy and active. They will understand the benefits of being healthy and physically active.

ENGLISH

Students will read, view and comprehend simple informative texts and create a written and multimodal informative text for an audience.

MATHEMATICS

Students will classify numbers as either odd or even, continue number patterns, recall addition facts for single-digit numbers and recognise the connection between addition and subtraction. They will tell time to the nearest minute and solve problems involving time. Students will collect and interpret data from simple chance experiments.

SCIENCE

Students will group living things based on observable features and distinguish them from non-living things.

HASS

Students will identify why Anzac Day commemorations are significant for different groups, pose questions about the significance of Anzac Day and use a text to formulate their questions. They will locate and collect information from the source.
