## **VETiS Certificate Courses**

Your child can now choose qualifications as an elective to complete in Year 10. TAFE Qld Roma Campus offer a range of qualifications that students can apply to study.

The choice on whether or not to study a qualification can become quite complex due to the courses' funding, which is under VETiS (VET in Schools) funding.

VETiS funding allows students to complete *one* employment stream qualification at the Certificate I or II level without cost. Some VETiS funded certificates are available to students in Year 10, while other courses cannot be accessed until Year 11. Students should not choose a VETiS funded course in Year 10 if they wish to use this funding on a different course in Year 11 or 12.

VETiS funded courses offered at TAFE Roma Campus include:

- Certificate II in Hospitality

- Certificate II in Health Support Services

- Certificate II in Rural Operations

- Certificate II in Electro-technology (Career Start)

- Certificate I in Construction
- Certificate II in Engineering

If students choose a certificate course as an elective, they must complete a TAFE application. Their enrolment is not guaranteed.
