On Line 7 (two 70-minute lessons a week), all students will rotate through each of the following four subjects over the full year: Business Studies; Visual Art; Digital Technology and STEM.

On Line 2 (three 70-minute lessons), students will choose ONE elective subject to study for the entire year. A brief synopsis of the subjects on Line 2 are:

Agricultural Science: this subject allows students to explore the ways people sustainably manage natural resources, such as plants, animals, climate, soil and water. The school farm is the hub of this program where students will develop their practical skills. Contains both theory and practical components. Assessment may include written tests, assignments, and observations.

Dance/Drama: This subject allows students to explore the different art forms including but not limited to Drama and Dance. Students will develop creativity, critical thinking, aesthetic knowledge and understanding about arts practices, through making and responding to works with increasing self-confidence.

Food Studies: This subject focuses on developing practical and theoretical knowledge on food and nutrition. Students will access the design and technologies curriculum, over the course of the year and assessment will include a combination of written and practical tasks.

Recreation: This subject focuses on social and competitive sport, fitness programs and outdoor pursuits. Students will develop interpersonal abilities and appreciate and value active involvement $n$ sporting and recreational activities contributing to ongoing personal and community development. Students who select this subject will complete theory and practical assessment.
