ENGLISH

Students will read, view and comprehend a simple informative text. They will create a short, written information text about a topic, using words and images.

MATHEMATICS

Students will partition and combine collections up to 10 in different ways. They will represent practical situations involving quantifying, adding to and taking away from collections to at least 10.

SCIENCE

In Science, we will observe external features of plants and animals and describe ways they can be grouped based on these features.

HOMEWORK

Each week we will send home a Dictation passage which has been read in class. The focus is on blending sounds together to read the words.

OTHER LEARNING AREAS

HASS This semester, students will be exploring important events celebrated in their lives, and identify how people and objects help them remember.

Performing Arts - (Miss McDonald) Tues: Prep C; Thurs: Prep K, Prep S

Prep students will be exposed to content relevant to Music, Dance, and Drama. They will participate in singing and playing musical instruments; dancing and moving their bodies; and acting and performing their favourite stories. Classes will also begin preparing for the 2025 Roma and District Speech and Drama Eisteddfod in which they will perform a poem as a whole class.

Technology - (Mrs Crawford) Tues: Prep S; Thurs: Prep C, Prep K
Students are exploring different digital systems and their components. They are also examining how to be safe online.

PE/Health- (Miss Dalton) Tues: Prep K; Thurs: Prep S, Prep C

- Catch that bean: Students will demonstrate personal and social skills for working with others in a range of activities. They will develop the fundamental movement skills of two handed catching and underarm throwing and explore dynamic balances with beanbags. They will apply these skills to solve movement challenges.
- I can do it: Students explore information about what makes them unique, identifying their strengths and achievements. Students identify safe settings where they can move and play safely and identify actions that keep them safe in different settings. Students identify different emotions people experience in different situations.
