ENGLISH

MATHEMATICS

OTHER LEARNING AREAS

HASS

This semester, students identify significant people and events in their own lives, and how significant events are celebrated or commemorated.

Digi-Tech - (Mrs Kate Crawford) Tues: Prep S, Prep B; Fri: Prep K

This semester students will be introduced to digital systems, safe technology use, routines and basic input skills through play, movement, storytelling and hands-on exploration. They will build their understanding and knowledge of digital literacies, predominantly with computers.

PE/Health- (Miss Dalton) Tues: Prep K, Prep B; Fri: Prep S

This term in HPE students will explore safe and healthy practices. They will investigate different types of health symbols on food products and household substances and how advertising influences food choices. Students will develop locomotor and non-locomotor skills, experiment with ways to move their bodies safely and identify the benefits of being physically active while practicing personal and social skills to interact respectfully with others.

Biological Sciences (Mrs McGregor) Tues: Prep K, Prep S; Fri: Prep B.

Students observe and explore the external features of plants and animals and learn how to group them based on similarities and differences.
