.......... ENGLISH

Students will read, view and comprehend an imaginative text. They will also create a short, written text to retell a familiar story. We will be learning the structure of a narrative story, through the exploration of popular fairytales.

MATHEMATICS

OTHER LEARNING AREAS

HASS This semester, students will identify, represent and describe the features of familiar places in their lives and suggest ways to care for their own specific place.

The Arts- (Miss Jess McDonald) This term in Performing Arts, students will be exposed to content relevant to Music, Dance, and Drama.
