ENGLISH

Students will be writing a recount of a familiar imaginative story. Students will also read, view and comprehend a simple decodable imaginative text.

MATHEMATICS

Students are developing their understandings of numbers up to 100 and beyond. They will focus on time duration and tell time to the half hour. Students will identify representations of one half. They will also carry out simple addition and subtraction problems.

SCIENCE

Students will be investigating the effects of interacting with different materials. They will participate in a guided investigation to design a toy that makes sound.

OTHER LEARNING AREAS

HASS: This semester, students will identify familiar places such as schools, local parks and local shops, who looks after these places and how they can care for these places. They will recognise different features of these familiar places such as natural, managed and constructed.

The Arts: This term in Drama, students will develop acting and improvising skills by engaging with various imaginative texts to experiment with creating and performing Drama. Classes will also be preparing for the 2024 Roma and District Eisteddfod. (Miss McDonald).

Physical Education: Students demonstrate fundamental movement skills (instep pass, punt kick and one hand strike) and test alternatives to solve movement challenges (to reach their targets). (Miss Dalton).

Health: Students describe physical and social changes that occur as they grow. They describe their personal strengths and achievements and discuss how these are acknowledged and celebrated. Students identify similarities and differences, and recognise how diversity contributes to identities. (Miss Dalton).

Media Arts: Students will explore manipulation and representation of self. (Mrs Crawford).
