YEAR FIVE - TERM TWO

ENGLISH

Students will read, view and comprehend informative texts about natural disasters, before creating their own multimodal informative text on a natural disaster of choice, for an audience.

MATHEMATICS

Students will learn about factors and multiples of numbers. They will also learn a range of multiplication and division strategies and use these to check the reasonableness of calculations. They will also use mathematical modelling to plan a fundraising activity to make a profit.

HASS - Students will identify how legal and environmental issues in Australian communities can be managed.

Science (Mrs Dallas McGregor) - Students will explore how weathering, erosion, transportation, and deposition slowly or rapidly change the Earth's surface.

HPE (Miss Agnes Dalton) - This semester students will focus on the topic of identity. Students will explore how different factors shape and influence identities, roles and responsibilities. Through role play and the use of reflective journals, students will explore how family, society, culture and media shape their values, beliefs and self-perception, including the influence of stereotypes. They will demonstrate self-regulation skills and strategies to manage emotions and stress while in game situations.

Music - This semester students will explain how music from other cultures communicates meaning.

Digital Technologies (Mrs Tennille Rhodes) - Students will learn how robots sense, move, and respond with programming to complete fun, real-world challenges. Through simple coding activities, they build teamwork and problem-solving skills to learn how robots work.
