## Under this agreement for 2018 Roma State College will receive

### This funding will be used to:

- ensure all students meet the National Minimum Standards (NMS) in NAPLAN in Reading and Writing
- increase percentage of students Upper Two Bands in Reading:

Year 3	40%
Year 5	35%
Year 7	15%
Year 9	15%

- increase attendance across the school to 90% in 2018
- ensure 100% of Year 12 students gain QCE in 2018
- attain the target of 85% 'C' or better in student academic outcomes
- support successful transition of Prep students into Roma State College in 2019.

### Our initiatives include:

- further embedding a systemic, detailed age appropriate P-12 College Reading Framework through explicit teaching and of reading strategies across all year levels
- evidence-based teaching and learning through timely and effective analysis of student data to inform whole school and individual improvement strategies
- continuing to use cycles of inquiry to build practices and processes where data is gathered and reviewed, and systematic improvements are initiated
- developing and enhance partnerships with parents and Early Learning Centres.

### Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- employing additional teacher/ teacher aides to support students in achieving NMS (\$150 000)
- employing literacy coaches to support staff to become confident and competent in the delivery of reading at Roma State College and accessing innovative professional learning initiatives across the college in areas of reading and literacy (\$70 000)
- providing professional learning and collaborative planning release time to enable teams and teachers to engage in collaborative data inquiry and collaborative planning conversations (\$50 000)
- employing staff in Student Wellbeing positions to support our students across P-12 (\$90 000)
- employing a 0.2 FTE Early Childhood teacher to support the transition to Prep (\$20 420).
